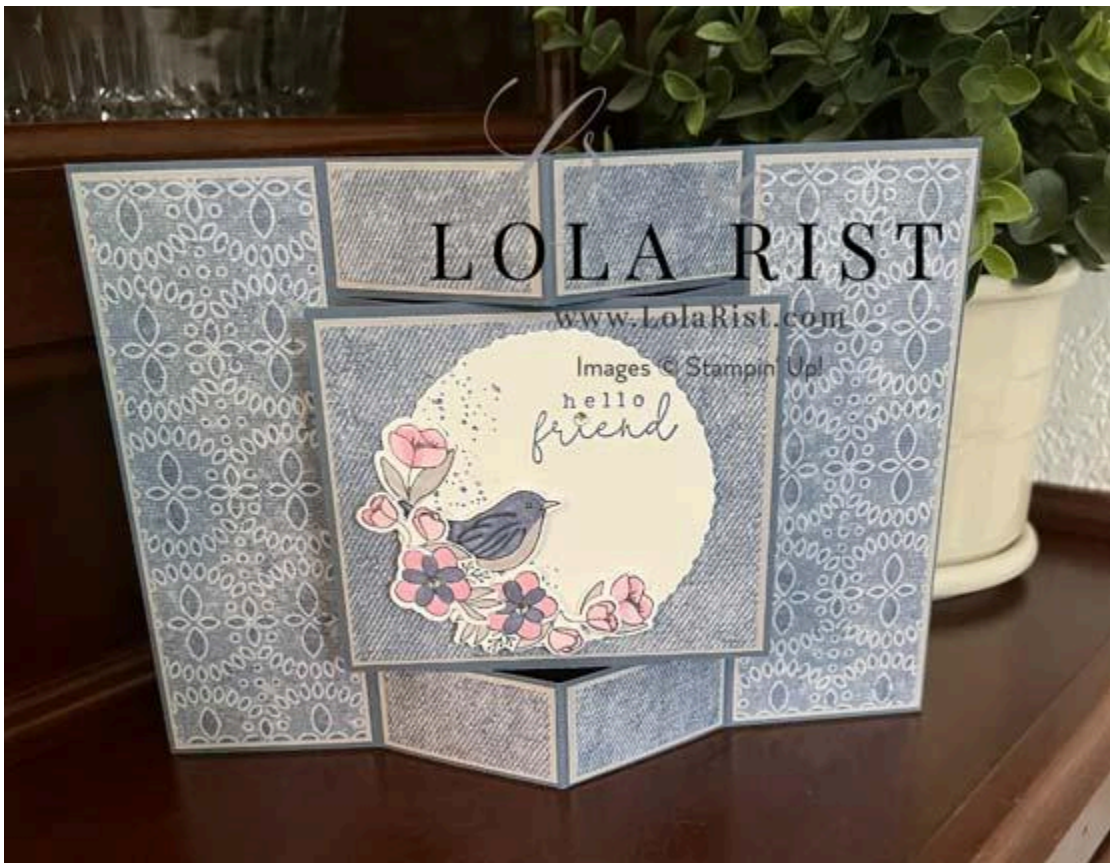

Front Panel Stepper Card May, 2024



Materials Used:

DSP

Country Lace

Card stock

Misty Moonlight, Smoky Slate, White

Ink

Misty Moonlight

Stamp Set/Dies

Country Birdhouse

Dies

Deckled Circles, birdhouse dies

Blends

Misty Moonlight, Smoky Slate, Bubble Bath

Card Base:

Misty Moonlight

5 ½ by 8 ⅛ inches. On the long side, Score at 2 ⅛ inch. Flip your card and Score the other end at 2 ⅛ inch too.

(more scoring info is given in directions, so please read ahead)

Front Panel

Cut Misty Moonlight Mat at 4 by 3 ¼ in.

Mats:

Smoky Slate

2 by 5 ⅜ inches - CUT 2

2 by 1 inches - CUT 4

3 ⅞ by 3 ⅛ inches - CUT 1

Basic White

2 by 5 ⅜ inches

DSP:

Country Lace

1 ⅞ by 5 ¼ inches - CUT 2

1 ⅞ by ⅞ inches - CUT 4

3 ¾ by 3 inches - CUT 1

I use scraps of Basic White for the circle, bird, and floral pieces.

Scoring/Prepping Card Base:

On the long side of the base, score at 2 1/8 inches. Flip the base and score the other end as well at 2 1/8 inches.

Turn your cardbase to the short side. CUT FROM ONE SCORE LINE TO THE OTHER SCORE LINE @ 1 1/8 inches. Flip the base and repeat this step, cutting between score lines at 1 1/8 inches.

Turn your base to the long side again. Score at 4 1/4 inches ONLY TO THE CUT LINES. Flip the base and repeat this step, scoring at 4 1/4 inch to the cut line.

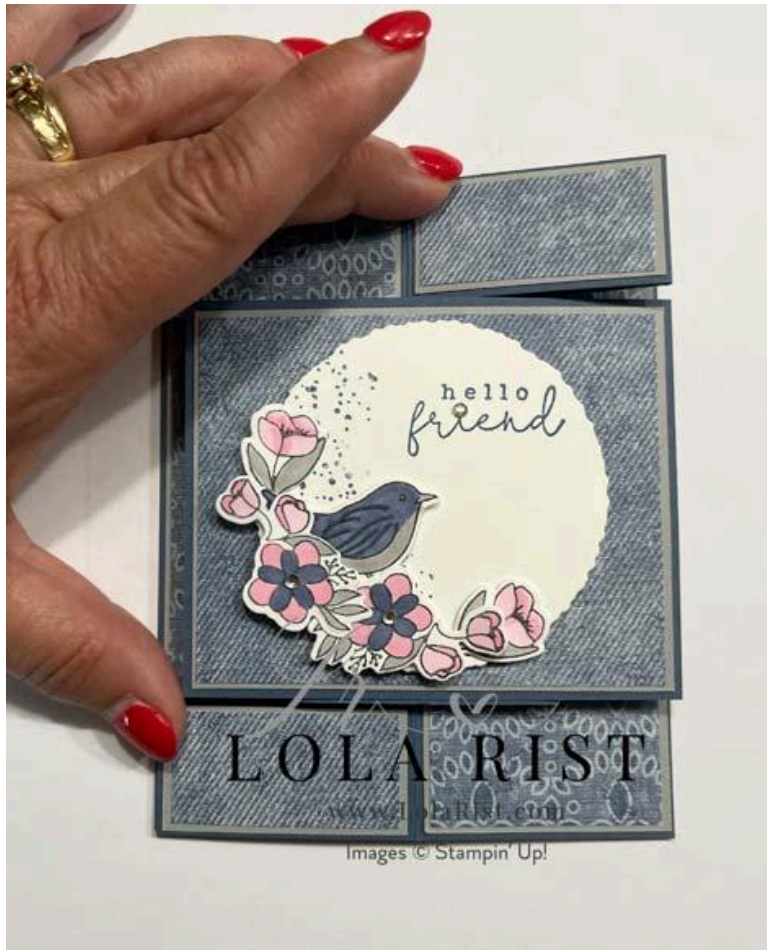
Using your bone folder, burnish all score lines. To make the front panel, fold on the score lines and bring together the side score lines. This will make the middle panel bump up, and you gently press down and crease. Burnish these next folds with your bone folder. (this will make more sense when watching the youtube video link.)

Glue all DSP mats to corresponding Smoky Slate mats, then adhere the Smoky Slate mats to the card base. Save the middle panel to the last. Lay card base flat, and ONLY PLACE ADHESIVE BETWEEN THE TWO FOLD LINES. Center your front panel, and press in place.

Add stamped greetings and die cuts. Adhere to the front panel with dimensionals.

Turn card base over and adhere the basic white panel for the message.
